

# Workshop promotes recovery through pen and paper

NURSE, HAS A TENDENCY TO

"stuff it," to take the feelings that surge
up inside and push them back down

## Select highlights from UC Davis Children's Hospital

 This past year we were re-verified as a level I Children's Surgery Center by the American College of Surgeons (ACS), the world standard bearer for surgical quality. Our state-of-the-art surgery center coupled with our world-class expertise helps us remain the only hospital in California with this verification.

 Our pediatric surgical patient volume has grown. Since we opened our new Children's Surgery Center in fall 2018, we have seen a strong increase in the number of children and families we have been able to serve, particularly in pediatric heart and neurosurgery cases as well as medically complex cases.

 In February 2019, the UC Davis Pediatric and Cardiac Intensive Care Unit (PICU) received the Silver-Level Beacon Award for Excellence from the American Association of Critical Care Nurses (AACN). It is an honor that involves a rigorous certification process, ensuring institutions have a commitment to nursing excellence, building strong relationships between patients, and improving outcomes and overall patient care satisfaction.

At UC Davis Health, we realize that every woman's birth experience is unique. We understand each woman and her family may have different preferences during labor and delivery and we strive to honor these preferences.

Like you, we share the common goal of a healthy mother and a healthy baby, but some pregnancies are higher risk than others and may require more interventions. These interventions may include continuous fetal monitoring, induction of labor or a cesarean section. It's important to have an ongoing discussion with your OB doctor regarding the risks you may face with your pregnancy or during your labor. Your doctor will help you understand the risks and benefits of some interventions that may be necessary to keep you and your baby safe.

The following form can help you communicate your wishes to your labor and delivery team. Please review this form with your doctor and then bring this information with you to the hospital to be shared with your care team.


Although a vaginal delivery is the goal for most uncomplicated pregnancies, some women will deliver by cesarean section. If this need anses for you, please indicate your preferences.

Some decisions before and during labor may affect your risk of cesarean section. It is important to have an ongoing discussion with your OB doctor during your prenatal visits. The following are common

- □ Admission to Labor and Delivery in active labor (4 to 6 cm) improves your chances of having a vaginal birth, as opposed to being admitted in early labor (less than 4 to 6 cm)
- C Our labor nurses are specially trained to coach you through your labor using a variety of techniques, positions, and medications. Your nurse will assist you and your family with techniques that can potentially help you cope with pain and increase your chance of having a vaginal delivery. Some of these techniques include the use of a birthing ball, a peanut ball or a rebozo. Your nurse can also help you with strategies to remain
- You may choose to have additional labor support by a trained caregiver called a doula (which can increase the likelihood of a vaginal delivery). However, we do not provide doula services and we do not have a referral list, but you may hire a doulaif you wish
